

Need

This leader in the field of tax and auditing services with offices throughout the U.S. was embarking on a refresh and upgrade of server and infrastructure technology for multiple local offices.

Solution

For more than twenty years, the company has trusted Liebert® power and thermal management technologies, and their Vertiv local business partner. They worked together to identify and standardize on a UPS configuration for the local offices, using the Liebert® GXT4™ in 6, 8 or 10 kVA capacities, depending on the compute needs of each office. Each UPS is equipped with the Liebert IS Unity Card for remote monitoring, and is covered by the Power Assurance Package to ensure hassle-fee maintenance. Thermal management is provided at each location through compact precision cooling units, including the Liebert Mini-Mate and Liebert PDX™.

Outcome

Working with a trusted partner with a full range of infrastructure solutions has allowed the company to support local offices with robust, reliable IT systems without burdening local staff with the task of monitoring or maintaining IT infrastructure.

Success Story: Adding Redundancy to Regional Offices Becomes Affordable with Liebert GXT UPS

Need

One of the top twenty banks in the U.S., with more than 1200 retail branches and over 40 regional offices, was experiencing problems with their regional office UPS systems. Maintenance costs on the oversized, three-phase UPS systems were climbing as they aged and the size of the units made adding redundancy too expensive.

Solution

Working with their Vertiv Local Business Partner, the bank was able to achieve 2N redundancy in all of their regional offices by replacing each three-phase UPS systems with two compact, single-phase 10 kVA Liebert GXT units in a redundant configuration. The rack-mount Liebert GXT UPS units were integrated in a secure Vertiv DCE[™] cabinet and arrived on site ready for fast installation.

Outcome

This solution provided the bank with greater reliability with UPS redundancy and enhanced physical security through the lockable DCE cabinet. Pre-integration of the UPS units in the cabinet simplified installation and saved about three man-hours of IT staff time per site.
