### **Quick Installation Guide**

Safety Instructions: Read these instructions before and during installation process. Keep this document after installation.

NOTE: Low ambient versions of the CoolPhase Condensing Unit do not require this accessory.

NOTE: With the wind baffle, the unit operation temperature range is  $-4^{\circ}F \sim 113^{\circ}F$  (-20°C  $\sim 45^{\circ}C$ )

The wind baffle allows Coolphase Condensing Unit operation at lower ambient outdoor temperature.

The following tools/equipment are required for the kit installation to the Unit:

- Screwdriver, for screw tightening and securing them to the Condensing Unit.
- Safety Gloves, for personal protection during installation.





Figure 1. Wind Baffle Kit components.



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




#### **Installation Procedure**


- **1.** The six M4 screws needed are already attached on the Condensing Unit, in the location shown below. Remove them before the wind baffle installation.
- **3.** Once the side pieces are assembled, take the front panel (1) and attach it using the four M4 screws (2) contained in the kit and secure them with a screwdriver.






**2.** From the front view near the fan placement, locate the corresponding screw location that matches with the holes of the panel, then attach both side panels (1) using the three M4 screws (2) on each one.

**4.** After attaching and securing the Wind Baffle (1), proceed with the Unit installation process indicated in the User Manual.





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#### **Installation Considerations**

# Clearance requirements


The following guidelines are needed to ensure optimal airflow, performance and maintenance to the unit while having the Wind Baffle installed:

1-Top: 11.8 in (300 mm) Minimum distance

2- Front: 23.6 in (600 mm) Minimum distance

3- Back: 11.8 in (300 mm) Minimum distance

4- Sides: 23.6 in (600 mm) Minimum distance



NOTE: When equipped with the Wind Baffle Kit, the maximum ambient air temperature is 118.4°F (48°C), but the cooling capacity will be reduced by 1.5%.

NOTE: If both the Hail Guard and Wind Baffle Kits are installed, the maximum ambient air temperature is 118.4°F (48°C), but the cooling capacity decreases by approximately 2%.
